Diamond D General Engineering has been awarded two contracts worth \$4,963,291 to demolish 314 single and multi-family housing units at Travis Air Force Base through the US Navy Resident Officer in Charge of Construction (ROICC). Diamond D will plan and coordinate pre-demolition activities that include removal and recycling of appliances, surveys to identify hazardous asbestos containing materials (ACM) and lead-based paint (LBP), ACM and LBP abatement, permitting, and cutting and capping of utilities prior to beginning demolition.

"We are pleased with this opportunity to support Travis AFB's program to modernize its housing stock," said Diamond D's president Spencer Defty. "We are clearing the way so that new housing can be constructed to improve the quality of the lives of the dedicated Air Force personnel and their families, who are sacrificing so much to maintain our freedom."
